Say No to Ragging

Ragging means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by other students and include individual or collective acts or practices which

- 1. Involve physical assault or threat to use physical force.
- 2. Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their selfesteem
- 3. Violate the status, dignity and honour of women students,
- 4. Violate the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the SC/ST.
- 5. Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behaviour.

Students of the College are expected to behave responsibly, both inside and outside the College. Ragging in any form is a criminal offence and is strictly prohibited. Any occurrence should be immediately reported to the Anti-ragging Committee.

Students must be respectful towards our National Heritage, National Flag and National Song.

- 1. Polite and respectful behaviour towards the Principal, teachers and non-teaching staff of the College and their fellow students is expected from a student of Asansol Girls' College.
